Financial Practitioners FinTech Training Programme 2022 concludes successfully

Commissioned by Financial Services and the Treasury Bureau (FSTB), the second round of Cyberport's Financial Practitioners FinTech Training Programme (Training Programme) Webinars Series ran from May to September this year, and has now successfully concluded. This round of the Training Programme saw a much more enthusiastic response, with over 2,600 financial practitioners taking part, more than doubling the last round. The number of participating financial institutions has also nearly doubled, from 49 to 91, reflecting the Training Programme's growing recognition and support within the financial industry.
